Arthritis Management for CHWs

This course explores the role of community health workers in supporting patient arthritis management including understanding risk factors, management, treatment, and referral.



CHW Role in Diabetes Care

In this course, learn about diabetes and how community health workers can play a vital role in managing this serious chronic health condition.



Heart Health Conditions: Education for CHWs

A short 10-minute course for community health workers that reviews the risk factors for heart health conditions and what can be done to reduce a client's risk.



Stroke Care for CHWs

A short 10-minute course for community health workers that reviews the risk factors for stroke and what can be done to reduce a client's risk.



Helping Clients with Asthma – A CHW Approach

This module provides the basic physiology and signs and symptoms of asthma; describes medications, presents the correct use of inhalers and spacers/holding chambers, and how to identify asthma triggers.

The Role of CHWs in Oral Health: This course provides a brief overview of oral health issues, the CHW scope of practice in oral health, and resources for oral health promotion.

Brushing for Two: This course provides an overview of dental conditions and oral health care during pregnancy and for infants and toddlers. The course also covers the CHW role for promoting oral health and providing resources.

Dementia Training for CHWs: This five-part course provides an overview of Alzheimer's and dementia, risk reduction, dementia detection, living with dementia and caregiver support.

How to get started

Once the survey is completed you will receive a certificate of completion.

About the CHW Training Program

MDH works with the Minnesota Community Health Worker Alliance, employers, and other organizations to strengthen and diversify the CHW workforce in Minnesota.

The CHW Training Program is funded by a three-year grant from the Health Resources and Services Administration to increase access to care and prevention services, strengthen the public health workforce, and achieve health equity in under-resourced communities.

The grant provides scholarships towards tuition for the CHW Certificate program, stipends for CHWs participating in registered apprenticeship programs, and increased training opportunities for new and existing CHWs.
