July 1, 2024

Submit cybersecurity assessment certification to MDH



- This requirement is for public water systems that use operational technology, such as Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA).
- Cybersecurity assessments may be selfassessments performed by the public water system or by a third party.

August 15, 2024

Submit service line inventory to MDH



- The Lead and Copper Rule Revisions (LCRR) require public water systems to complete an inventory of all service lines in the distribution system.
- Inventory information will be uploaded into the Minnesota Lead Inventory Tracking Tool to meet State law and LCRR notification requirements.

August 1<u>5</u>, 2024

Deadline for interest in free technical assistance on climate resiliency



- Drinking water, wastewater, and stormwater utilities are eligible to receive free technical assistance on climate risk assessment from U.S.
 Environmental Protection Agency's Creating Resilient Water Utilities (CRWU) initiative.
- CRWU will help approximately 75 utilities and communities identify long-term climate change adaptation strategies and potential funding options.
