

# Water Service Line Pressure Testing

## Pressure test requirements

Water service lines must be tested upon completion. If not observed by a Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) inspector, pressure tests must be accompanied by an affidavit signed by the contractor and the owner or owner's agent who witnessed the test. The affidavit must state the type of test, testing pressure and timed length of test. Only testing procedures from [Minnesota Plumbing Code \(https://epubs.iapmo.org/2020/MPC/\)](https://epubs.iapmo.org/2020/MPC/) Section 609.4 will be allowed.
