How to Change Languages in Internet Browsers: English

Microsoft Edge

Automatic Translation

When you visit a page written in a language different from your preferred languages, Microsoft Edge will automatically prompt you to translate it.

- 1. Look for the Translate icon in the address bar when you encounter a foreign language page.
- 2. Choose the language you want to translate the page into from the dropdown.
- 3. Click on Translate.
- 4. You can also select the "Always translate from [Language]" option to automatically translate from the source language.

Manual Translation

If you've set Microsoft Edge to never translate a specific language, you won't see automatic prompts, however, you can still manually translate it.

- 1. Click the Translate icon in the address bar.
- 2. Select the desired target language.
- 3. Click Translate.

Adjust Settings

To modify translation settings:

- 1. Go to ellipses to the right of the address bar.
- 2. Click on Settings.
- 3. Click on Languages.
- 4. Enable or disable "Offer to translate pages that aren't in a language I read."

Google Chrome

Automatic Translation

When you encounter a foreign language page, Chrome will offer to translate it.

- 1. Click the Translate icon in the address bar.
- 2. Choose your preferred language.

3. Chrome will translate the current webpage.

Manual Translation

- 1. Highlight a section of text on the page.
- 2. Right-click and select Translate selection to [Language].

Adjust Settings

To control translation behavior:

- 1. Click More (three dots) > Settings.
- 2. Go to Languages.
- 3. Turn Use Google Translate on or off.
- 4. Choose the default language for translation.

Mozilla Firefox

Automatic Translation

- Firefox's translation feature continuously translates webpages in real-time.
- No data leaves your device, ensuring privacy.
- Supported languages include Spanish, English, German, Bulgarian, Portuguese, Italian, and more

Manual Translation

- 1. Click the Firefox Translations icon in the address bar.
- 2. Choose a language to translate into.

Adjust Settings

No need to enable or disable; translations are private by design.
