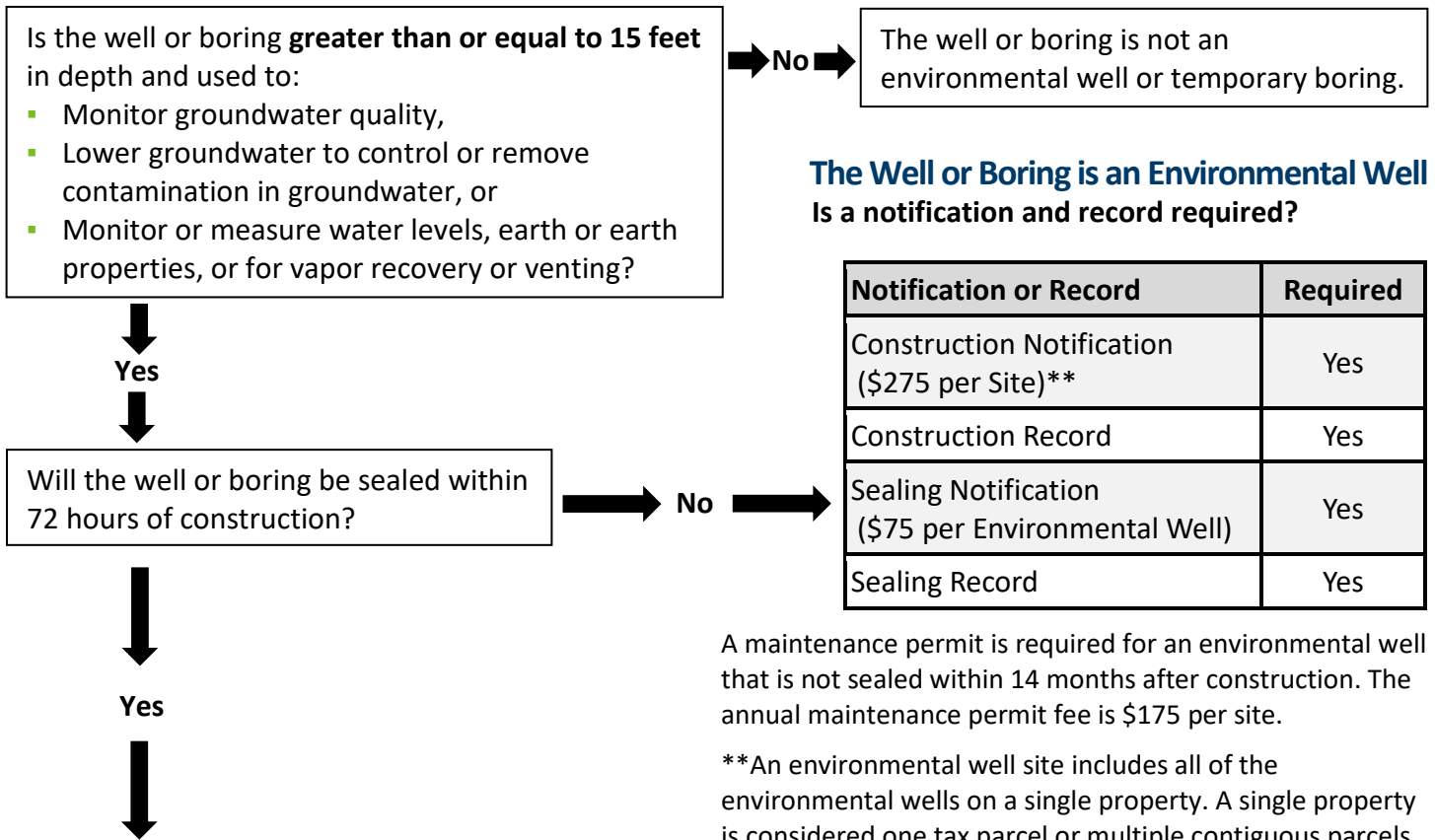


Identifying Environmental Wells/Temporary Borings and Determining Administrative Requirements



The Well or Boring is a Temporary Boring Is a notification and record required?

Notification or Record	Temporary Boring is Greater Than or Equal to 25 Feet in Depth	Temporary Boring is Less Than 25 Feet in Depth
Construction Notification	No	No
Construction Record	No	No
Sealing Notification (\$75 per Site)*	Yes	No
Sealing Record*	Yes	Yes

*Multiple temporary borings on a single site can be recorded on a **single sealing notification** and/or a **single sealing record**.

Note: Local delegated well programs with environmental well authority are Dakota, Olmsted, and Winona counties and the cities of Bloomington and Minneapolis.
