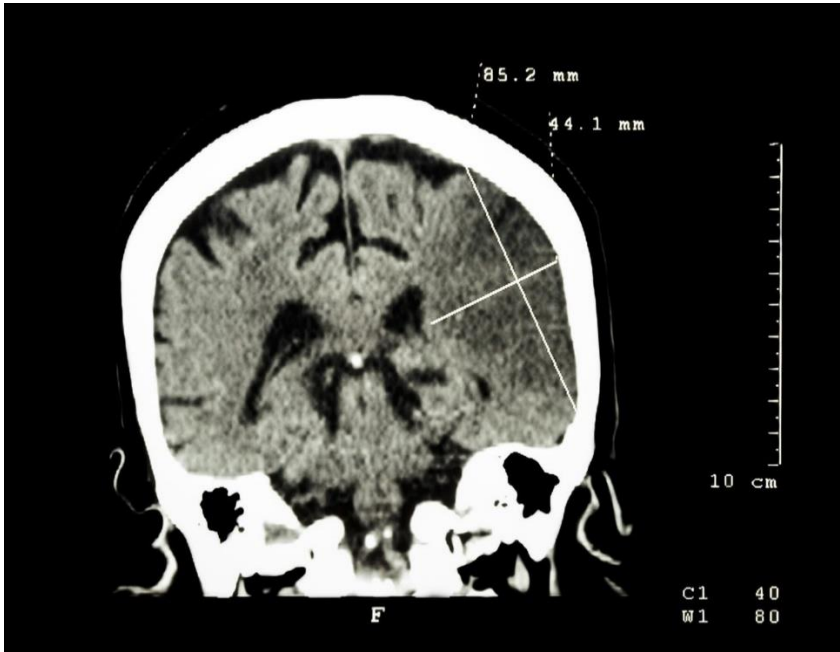


Free Stroke Education
