Syphilis during pregnancy is on the rise in Minnesota.

It's easy to get tested, and if you have syphilis, **it's curable.**



You should be tested for syphilis **three times** during your pregnancy:

1. During your first visit
2. At 28-32 weeks
3. At delivery

Syphilis can:

- Be passed on to infants during pregnancy or during delivery and can be life threatening.
- **Be cured.**
There are ways to protect yourself and your baby.
