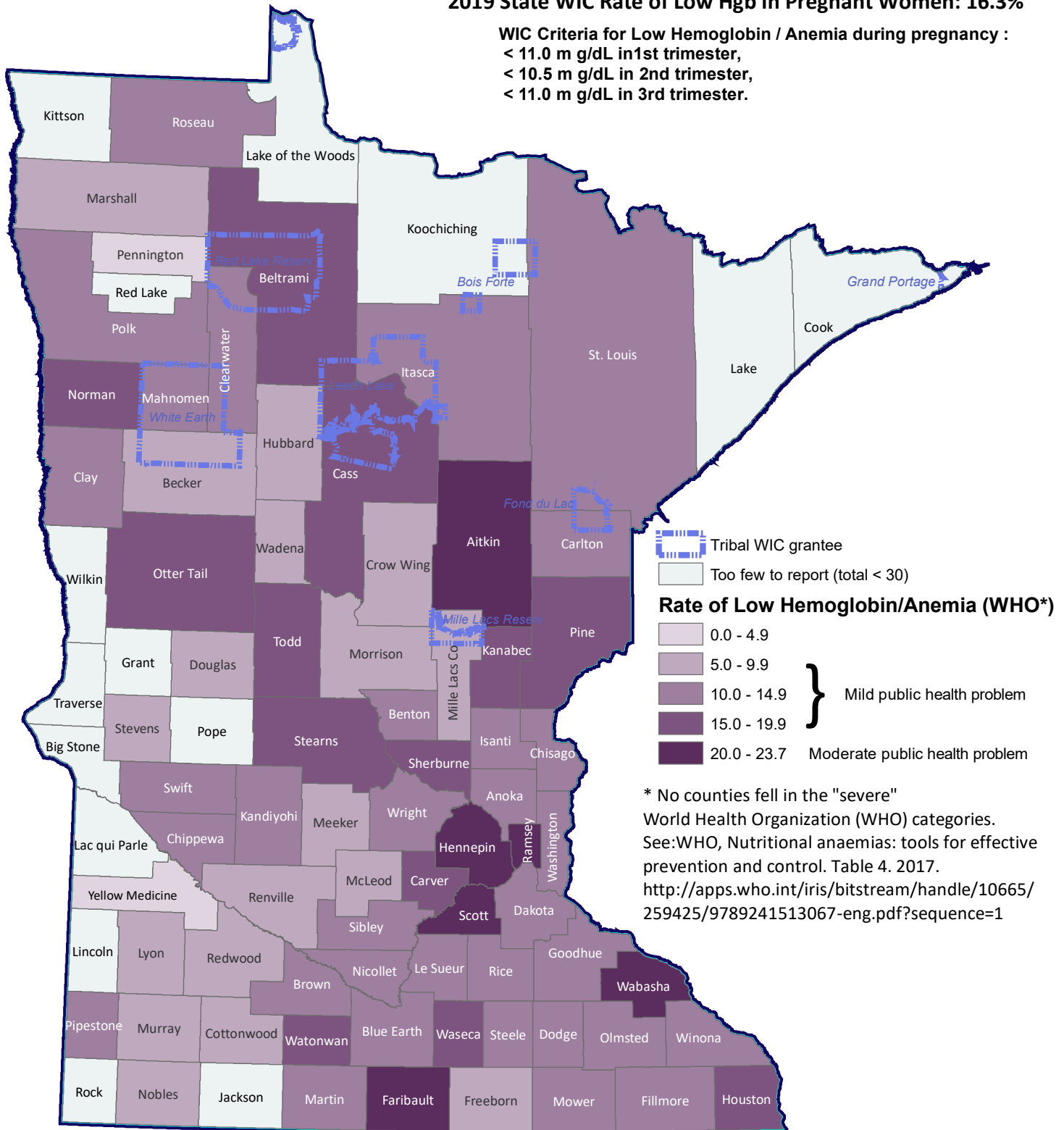


# Iron Status during WIC Pregnancy by County of Residence, 2019

2019 State WIC Rate of Low Hgb in Pregnant Women: 16.3%

WIC Criteria for Low Hemoglobin / Anemia during pregnancy :  
 < 11.0 m g/dL in 1st trimester,  
 < 10.5 m g/dL in 2nd trimester,  
 < 11.0 m g/dL in 3rd trimester.
