

New and Improved Nurse Aide Registry Coming Soon!

What is it?

The Minnesota Nurse Aide Registry is transitioning to become 100% digital in a new, secure, and mobile-optimized system. Early January 2024, the new and improved Nurse Aide Registry will be available. This new system transitions MDH and the nurse aides to a fully digital experience, which streamlines and improves updates, renewals, and interstate endorsements.

Active Nurse Aides will be able to:

- Update their contact information
- View and update their employer information
- Renew their certificate
- View testing history, and
- Print their certificate

Nurse Aides who are endorsing from another state will be able to create an account, upload supporting documents and submit their application online.
