### **Test Site Reminders**





#### **Both Servers**

#### ✓ All testing events must be closed and locked-**MN Server**

#### ✓ Provide current directions and signage to testing location

# ✓ Verify with HM if unsure if a candidate has a testing record before entering in TMU



#### **Before Test Event**

Enter testing dates in TMU at least 2 weeks prior to the testing date, or as soon as possible



Enter challenge candidates into TMU 1-2 business days after application submitted



Check for completion of training program **prior** to scheduling the tests. This ensures the candidate can benefit from other opportunities, such as nursing and TMA.

#### Questions to ask the candidate:

- > Have you challenged the exam in the past?
- Have you tested under a different name?
- > Did you fail your exams at any time?
- If you have gone through a training program, have you failed/exhausted all testing attempts?
- If you have failed all testing attempts, have you completed a new training program?







As a Primary Instructor teaching nurse aide training, you will need to request a login to access TMU©. If you do not have a login, the **INSTRUCTOR LOGIN REQUEST** can be found on the Minnesota TMU© main page under **APPLICATIONS**.

If you give or receive help from anyone during testing (which also includes the use of any electronic recording devices such as cell phones, smart watches, or navigating to other browsers/sites during an electronic exam, etc.), your test will be stopped, you will be dismissed from the testing room, and your test will be scored as a **failure**. You will forfeit any testing fees paid. You will be reported to your training program and MDH, and you may need to obtain permission from MDH in order to be eligible to test again.




#### **Exempt from Testing**

#### Nurse Aide Testing Information - MN Dept. of Health

Candidates who have cheated on either the knowledge or skills exam will be exempt from any testing opportunities for 45 calendar days.



# **Survey Findings**





#### Documentation

✓ TP's have various online learning management systems

- Must be able to track cumulative hours spent and show at time of survey
- ✓ Make up hours must be tracked and accounted for
- ✓ Self study hours are not accepted unless completed during class time



#### CFR 483.152

- § 483.152 Requirements for approval of a nurse aide training and competency evaluation program.
- (a) For a nurse aide training and competency evaluation program to be approved by the State, it must, at a minimum—
- (1) Consist of no less than 75 clock hours of training;
- (2) Include at least the subjects specified in <u>paragraph (b)</u> of this section;
- (3) Include at least 16 hours of supervised practical training. Supervised practical training means training in a laboratory or other setting in which the trainee demonstrates knowledge while performing tasks on an individual under the direct supervision of a registered nurse or a licensed practical nurse;
- (4) Ensure that—
- (i) Students do not perform any services for which they have not trained and been found proficient by the instructor; and





For a nurse aide training and competency evaluation program to be approved by the State, it must, at a minimum include at least 16 hours of supervised practical training. Supervised practical training means training in a laboratory or other setting in which the trainee demonstrates knowledge while performing tasks on an individual under the direct supervision of a registered nurse or a licensed practical nurse;	
This STANDARD is not met as evidenced by: Based on record review and staff interview, it was not possible to determine the actual hours of supervised practical training for 2 of 3 classes reviewed. Findings include;	
Documentation of three classes was reviewed: 6/1/20 to 6/12/20, 7/12/21 to 7/23/21 and 8/2/21 to 8/13/21.	
Instructors A and C documented only the the date of supervised practical training and did not include the number of hours for the June and July 2021 classes.	



#### **Reminder to Instructors**

Enter the Student's FIRST and LAST name as it appears on their government issued ID, cell phone number and personal e-mail address

The cell phone number and email address are used to receive text notifications regarding testing and renewals

Their email address is used to log into TMU

Students must complete their TMU account at least 48 hours before testing to review demographic information and ensure accuracy



### **Testing Page**

#### <u>Nurse Aide Testing Information - MN Dept. of Health</u> Nurse Aide Registry Testing Information

MDH selected D&SDT-Headmaster as the test contractor for placement on the Minnesota Nurse Aide Registry. Testing on the Headmaster platform began on Feb. 1, 2022. Testing materials, candidate handbooks, and information about training sessions for the platform are posted on the <u>D&SDT-Headmaster - Minnesota Nurse Aide website</u>.

#### Two-Server System for testing

D&SDT-Headmaster offers a two-server system for testing in effort to accommodate as many students as possible:

- MN State Colleges and Universities throughout the state
- MDH approved in-facility test sites throughout the state

Students who plan to test at an in-facility test site should be enrolled in the In-Facility Server. Students who wish to test at a MN State Colleges and Universities test site should be enrolled in the Minnesota State server. **Once a student has tested in a server, they must complete all test attempts in the same server.** 



#### **Two Server System**

#### Registration

#### MN State Colleges and Universities

Registration for the Nurse Aide Skills and Knowledge tests is available on the MN State Colleges and Universities website. Nurse Aide candidates who have completed their training program or would like to challenge the test can register for a date and time at the <u>Minnesota State Nursing Assistant Testing</u> website.

#### In-Facility (MDH approved test sites)

#### Test Out/Challenge Candidates

#### MN State Colleges and Universities

Test out/challenge candidates MUST contact a test site of choice to schedule a knowledge and skills test. <u>Minnesota State - Nursing Assistant Testing (minnstate.edu)</u>

#### In-Facility (MDH approved test sites)

Test out/challenge candidates MUST complete an application to schedule a knowledge and skills test: <u>Test-Out or Challenge Candidate Application Form 1101 Application</u>

### **Time Frame for Testing**

# Time Frame for Testing, 24 Month Test Cycle

You have four (4) attempts to pass the knowledge exam and three (3) attempts to pass the skills exam either:

- within 24 months of your date of training program completion
- or from the first (skills or knowledge) test attempt as a challenge candidate

If you have **exhausted** your knowledge **OR** skill attempts prior to the 24-month cycle ending, you **MUST** complete another MDH-approved training program **BEFORE** you are eligible to re-test.

If 24-month testing cycle has expired and candidate DID NOT exhaust all testing attempts in the 24 month testing cycle, the candidate can either:

- 1. Complete new training program OR
- 2. Test as a challenge candidate



### **Example Given**

Candidates CANNOT use previous successful test results for the new testing cycle. When a new training program is completed, this will void all past training and testing attempts.

Example:

On 3/1/24, candidate passes challenge knowledge attempt and fails skill attempt.

On 3/10/24, candidate fails 2nd skills attempt.

On 8/1/24, candidate enrolls in training program.

On 8/31/24, candidate completes training program. The 24-month cycle starts over.

Candidate must test for both knowledge and skills now that they have completed a new training program, as this new training program voids all past training and testing.



#### Nurse Aide Registry: Frequently Asked Questions about NATCEPs - MN Dept. of Health

Do self-study guides or self-reported hours count as clock-hours towards the required 75-hour total?

No. Self-study or self-reported hours are not eligible to count towards the 75-hour total. If time spent on study guides can be tracked or recorded in an online learning management system, this would be allowable. Refer to <u>federal regulation</u> <u>483.152</u> for additional information.






#### Nurse Aide Registry (NAR) Updates & Best Practices

### **Updates & Reminders**



- Nurse Aides can submit renewals with supporting documents.
- Facilities (e.g., nursing home, certified boarding care home) can submit staff reporting.
- Renewals can be submitted 90 days from expiration date.
- Email notification sent to nurse aides: 90, 60, 30, 14, 7 days, and on the day of the expiration.
- Applications are processed within 30 business days after receipt.
- Updates to the NAR website.

### **Best Practices**

- Facilities must click "Submit Facility Nursing Aide Staff Report" to extend the expiration date of their nurse aides' certificates for staff reporting.
  - See guidance on the <u>State Operations Manual (SOM) Appendix PP, Guidance</u> <u>§§483.35(d)(4)-(6)</u> regarding documentation to verify individuals performing nursing or nursing-related services for monetary compensation during the previous 24 months.
- Other health care providers (such as assisted living, home health agencies, hospices, hospitals) should instruct their nurse aide employees to use the online system to submit their renewal applications.
- After receiving a legitimate Social Security Number (SSN) together with legal documentation, those who tested without one must contact the registry to have their certificate record reviewed and updated.



The Nurse Aide Registry lists nurse aides who have met Minnesota training and/or testing standards to work in nursing homes and certified boarding care homes. The registry also has information about nurse aides who have substantiated findings of abuse, neglect, and theft.

This is an online registry. Nurse aides, employers, and others can check the registry by using MDH's online system and the nurse aide's certificate number.

- Application packet for approval of a nurse aide training program is a fillable form and available online: <u>Nurse Aide Training and Competency Evaluation Program</u> <u>(NATCEP) Provisional Application Form (PDF)</u>.
- 2. An approved nurse aide training and competency evaluation program must be at least 75 clock hours in length. Training includes 16 hours of supervised practical training with a live person in a laboratory or other setting and curriculum instruction/skills totaling 75 hours. Location of or method of curriculum instruction and supervised practical training identified in application packet. A list of suggested equipment is available here: <u>Nurse Aide Training Equipment (PDF)</u>
