Licensing requires that an applicant may qualify for licensing by documenting completion of every requirement necessary to obtain certification of clinical competence in audiology (CCC-A) from the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association (ASHA) or board certification in audiology by the American Board of Audiology (ABA). The Applicant must, in part, document the completion of supervised clinical training by obtaining the signature of the appropriate person(s) in the institution(s) where the training occurred. The training must meet the requirements prescribed by ASHA or ABA.
