Vendor Sought to Produce Trauma Education Videos

The Statewide Trauma System is entertaining bids from organizations that would like to produce a series of self-study educational modules that provide basic trauma education for nurses. The educational modules will be used by registered nurses and licensed practical nurses to satisfy the training requirements for Level 3 and 4 Trauma Hospitals.

Nurses working at a designated trauma hospital can satisfy the training requirements by taking an organized course such as *Comprehensive Advanced Life Support* or *Trauma Nurse Core Course*, or hospitals can develop their own educational curriculum that satisfies the objectives published in the Level 3 and Level 4 trauma hospital designation criteria. The educational modules will satisfy those same objectives.

Several hospitals and educational institutions are likely in a position to produce the modules. [Download the Request for Proposals from the Trauma System website.](#) Proposals must be received by March 1, 2021.
