RSV monoclonal antibody ordering

Two respiratory syncytial virus (RSV) monoclonal antibody (mAb) products, nirsevimab (Beyfortus) and clesrovimab (Enflonsia), will be available to order soon through the Minnesota Vaccines for Children (MnVFC) program.

How to order: Submit your initial RSV mAb requests for the beginning of the season under "Request Special Event Vaccine" in MIIC. The event will be open for on-time requests from **Aug. 3 to Aug. 14**. Place a request for the number of RSV mAb doses you expect to need for the **first month of the administration season (Oct. 1 through Oct. 31)**.

If you need more doses than initially requested, you can submit requests for additional doses at any time. We will process orders as we have access to doses from CDC. Sites might receive a few small shipments throughout the initial rollout period. You can check the status of your requests in MIIC. Keep in mind when ordering:

- Only order the number of doses you have capacity to store.
- We recommend you only carry one product (nirsevimab or clesrovimab) at your location to minimize potential administration errors.

Consider the following to estimate your initial order:

- Any doses borrowed (refer to your borrowing report), or unexpired doses remaining in your refrigerator from the previous season.
- Expected Abrysvo uptake for pregnant patients.
- Babies born since the end of last RSV season and children ages 8-19 months entering their second RSV season who are at increased risk of severe RSV disease.
- Any doses for newborns you expect to be born during October, and babies born over the summer whose parents are eager to get their kids immunized early in the season.

MnVFC Abrysvo available for maternal vaccination

The Pfizer RSV vaccine Abrysvo will be available to order for MnVFC-eligible pregnant teens 18 years of age and younger in August. It should be given to pregnant people at 32 to 36 weeks' gestation from September through January to protect newborns from RSV. Babies born at least two weeks after the birthing parent's vaccination with Abrysvo should not receive RSV mAb except in rare circumstances. If a pregnant person received RSV vaccine during a previous pregnancy, do not use Abrysvo during this one, and counsel them that a dose of RSV mAb should be given to the infant shortly after birth. Sites that have multiple RSV products should educate staff on the different uses and indications to avoid vaccination errors. Arexvy (GSK) and mResvia (Moderna) are not approved for use in pregnant people.

Abrysvo will be on the MnVFC order form in MIIC starting Aug. 1, ahead of the administration window, to ensure you have time to order and have stock ready to administer starting Sept. 1.
