

Minnesota Innovations in Perinatal Health

The Minnesota Department of Health released the [Minnesota Innovations in Perinatal and Infant Health Request for Proposals](#) in March 2024. There were two tracks of funding. Track one was focused on perinatal health innovations and track two was focused on [infant health innovations](#). Through category one, innovative activities in community engagement and communications focused on improving perinatal health, were funded. After a robust review community review process, five applicants were selected for funding. Grantees started their projects in early June. The grant period is from June 2024 – September 2025.
